#### October 6, 2023

Dear Parishioners of St. Ann's Quesnel, My name is Fr Paul Simms, and on October 4<sup>th</sup> Bishop Joseph asked me to take on the responsibility of Parochial Administrator of St. Ann's. This appointment is what we call pro tem, that is, for a time until a pastor is assigned to the parish. I remain the pastor of Sacred Heart in Williams Lake and the surrounding missions in addition to this new responsibility.

Another priest, Fr Brendan M., has been assigned to Sacred Heart Williams Lake. He has recently arrived in Canada from Nigeria, and needs time to become familiar with our country and culture. Fr Swann Kim is also serving in Sacred Heart Williams Lake as an assistant priest.

For the time being, myself and Frs. Swann and Brendan, will do our best to serve you, and all the other peoples and communities entrusted to us. Unfortunately, for the time being, this will mean that things will not be as they have been. The most obvious example of this will be the number and availability of Masses in Quesnel. At the very least, I will try to ensure that there is always a Sunday Mass and at least one weekday Mass every week.

A week ago, I was unaware that this new adventure would be happening. Undoubtedly and reasonably, many of you will have questions about what is going on and why, especially regarding the future. If I could

answer those questions for you I would; but to be honest, I don't know and am trying to figure things out myself, beginning with making sure there are Sunday Masses.

What I can tell you is this — the Lord is good, and he remains the real shepherd of the parish. Although things might be a little messy and uncomfortable, He knows what He is doing, and knows how to lead all of us. While I ask for your patience with me, I more earnestly ask that you entrust yourselves anew to our Saviour Jesus Christ, and ask through the intercession of his grandmother, St Ann, that all will be done according to His will.

God bless all of you, and I look forward to seeing you this Sunday.
