Please note that the Healing and Reconciliation Fund second collection is coming up on Sunday, November 12th.

The 3rd Indigenous Reconciliation Fund collection will take place on Sunday November 12 in the Diocese of Kamloops. The Indigenous Reconciliation Fund is \$30 million – it is made up of an assessment on a Diocese-by-Diocese basis – the Kamloops Diocese's assessment is \$150,000; this amounts to a 5 year collection target of \$30,000 per year. In the first two years of the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund collections, the parishioners in the Diocese of Kamloops have been very generous, giving approximately \$60,000 towards this fund which means we are on schedule with our assessment amount. Thank you again for your generosity in 2021 and 2022 and please be generous again this year in our collective desire to support this most worthy cause and to assist our Indigenous people in their healing.
