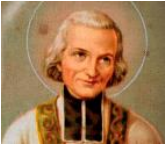

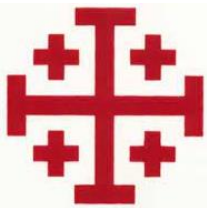


DIVINE MERCY NOVENA BEGINS GOOD FRIDAY
