

Saint Faustina thanked Jesus "for the little daily crosses, for opposition to my endeavors, for the hardships of communal life, for the misinterpretation of my intentions, for humiliations at the hands of others, for the harsh way in which we are treated, for false suspicions, for poor health and loss of strength, for self-denial, for dying to myself, for lack of recognition in everything, for the upsetting of all my plans"

(D, #343). She also wrote that, "Great love can change small things into great ones, and it is only love which lends value to our actions" (D, # 303). She wrote about rejection and humiliation. "When I fell ill and was taken to the infirmary, I suffered much unpleasantness because of this. There were two of us sick in the infirmary. Sisters would come to Sister N, but no one came to visit me" (*Diary of St. Faustina*, 149).

Yet she maintained her trust in God in spite of all her trials and tribulations, adding, "Oh, how pleasing are the hymns flowing from a suffering soul! All heaven delights in such a soul, especially when it is tested by God. It mournfully sings out its longing for Him. Great is its beauty, because it comes from God. The soul walks through the jungle of life, wounded by God's love. With one foot only it touches the ground" (114).).~St
