## Big Six Award



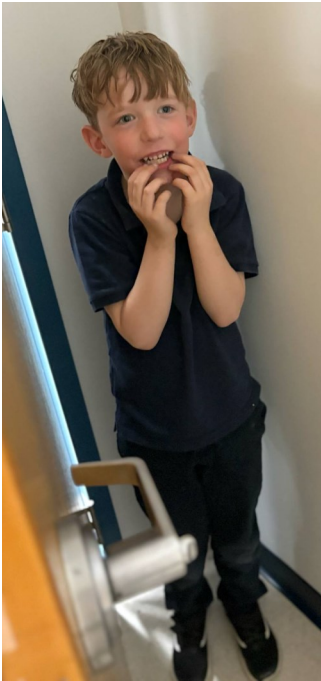
The Big Six award for the month of April was for students who showed great team work. It could be in sports, the classroom or the playground.

# Lhtako Dene Field Trip



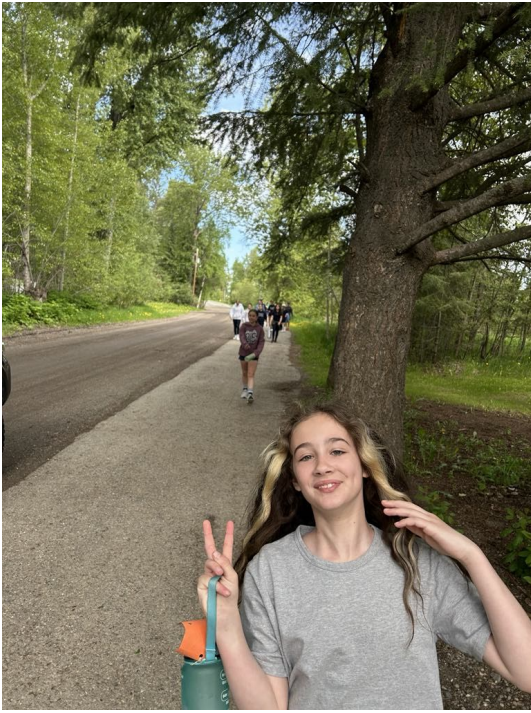

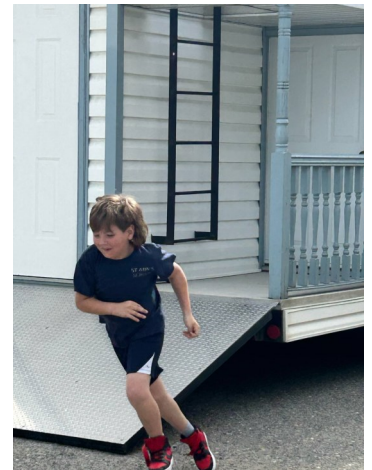




# Fire house

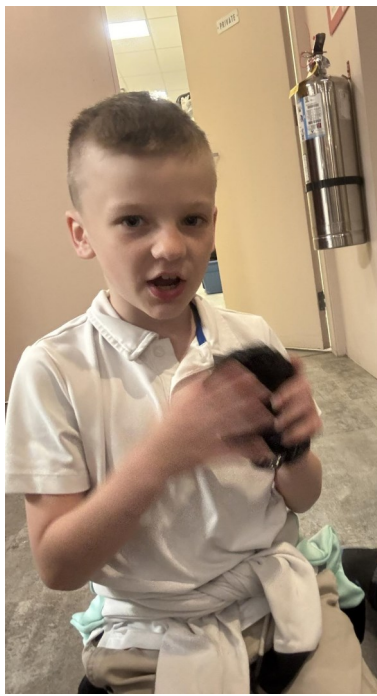


# Lenten Donation
