John Vianney was born in 1786 near Lyons, France. It was just a few years prior to the French Revolution and the execution of countless priests, nuns, religious, and faithful Catholics. But the evil events of the French Revolution and Reign of Terror only strengthened Vianney's faith, and upon reception of his first Communion he heard God's call to the priesthood.
