"After having reached the age of discretion, each member of the faithful is obliged to confess faithfully his or her grave sins at least once a year" (CIC 989).

A message from Jessie Parkinson, National CWL Chairperson of Social Justice:

Exerpt: “Bill C-218 is an important bill in ongoing efforts to protect vulnerable populations from choosing to die because Canada does not have adequate resources to treat mental illness. It is scheduled for second reading in the House of Commons on December 5th.

In the second reading the MP who put forward the bill outlines the principles of the bill, followed by a debate and a vote. If the vote passes, the bill is referred to a committee that studies it and may hear witnesses and make amendements before referring it back to the House for a third and final reading. Second reading is a crucial step in the process as if the vote is unsuccessful it dies there. Please inform members and request that they urgently **contact their MPs to ask them to support Bill C-218.** Letters, emails and telephone calls are important.”
